Mount Roraima is Arthur Conan Doyle's lost world – a colossal plateau skirted on all sides by sheer vertical cliffs up to 600 meters tall. The summit of the mountain has remained isolated for millions of years, and today is home to the greatest concentration of unique plants and animals found on Earth, including ancient living fossils that have remained little-changed since the time of the dinosaurs. This “lost world” is also home to many of the strangest landscapes of our world, including valleys of crystals, banks of gemstones, and labyrinths of towering stone pinnacles. However, increasing accessibility, the introduction of foreign plants and animals, illegal gold mining are seriously degrading this unique natural wonder.
